

GOOD LAUNDRY PRACTICE

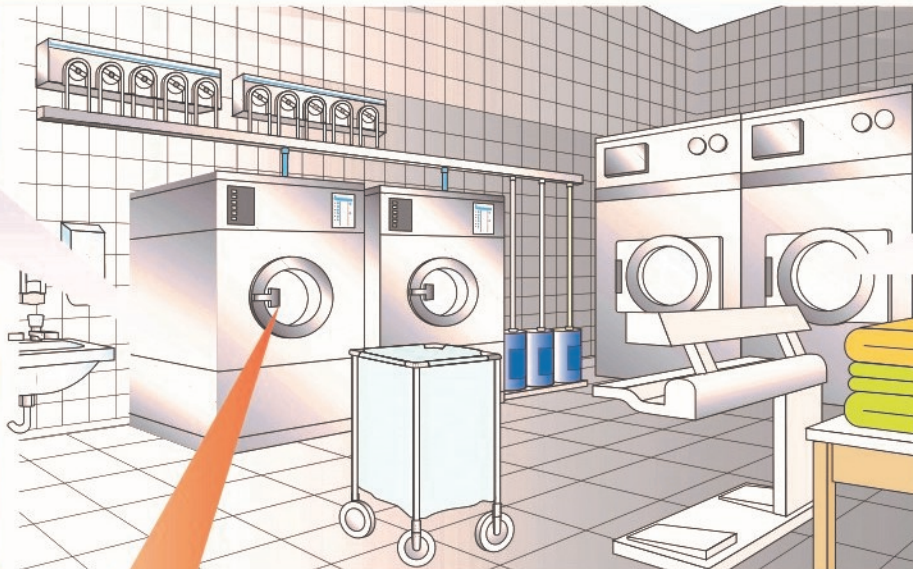
SORTING LINEN

CORRECT

- Do pre-sort linen into marked bins/containers.
- Do keep clean linen away from soiled linen and ensure that it does not come into contact with dirty floors, walls or carts.

WRONG

- Don't store any linen on the floor - always use containers/trolleys.
- Don't drag linen across the floor.



DRYING AND FINISHING LINEN

CORRECT

- Do load machines with the correct weight/number of items.
- Do select 'cooldown' option when drying polycotton items.
- Do inspect linen for wear/tear/stains and send for repair, if necessary.

WRONG

- Don't overdry - this will cause excessive creases to linen.
- Don't leave fabric in dryer after cycle has finished.
- Don't leave washed linen wet overnight.

WASHING LINEN

CORRECT

- Do load machines with the correct weight/number of items.
- Do select correct wash processes.
- Do use a trolley to transport linen within laundry.

WRONG

- Don't overload or underload the machines.
- Don't alter the wash process cycles - this may lead to poor results.
- Don't stop a cycle halfway through - this could damage the fabric.

DAILY CLEAN DOWN

- Do clean all equipment, carts, tables and floors - do clean lint filters.
- Do check levels in product containers.
- Do wait until end of cycle before switching off equipment at the isolators.
